Horn for NC House

Mr. D. Craig Horn today filed his candidacy for the Republican nomination for the North Carolina House of Representatives, District 68. Craig, 65, and his wife Lorraine live in Weddington, NC and he currently serves on the Union County, NC Fire Commission. Craig has previously been elected to three terms on the City Council in Laurel, MD and was appointed to the Economic Development Commission in Howard County, MD. Craig is Chairman of the Churchill Society of North Carolina and the founder of the North Carolina Winston Churchill Seminars for High School Students and Teachers. Craig is a member of the Republican Men's Club of Union County and the Union County Republican Forum.

He volunteers in two Union County Schools and speaks a various community organizations on history and politics.
